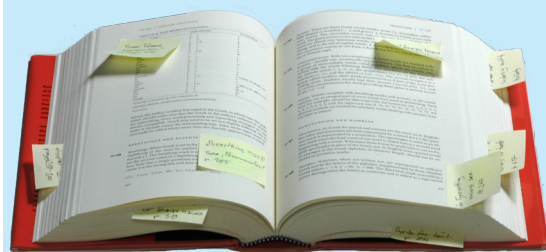

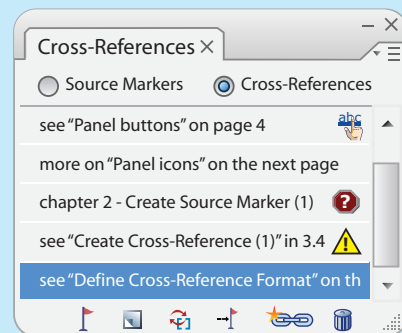
Cross-References is a modular xml driven referencing system inspired by a similar feature in Adobe FrameMaker and improved thanks to the greater flexibility of the InDesign environment.

KEY FEATURES:

- File name, page number, paragraph number, paragraph text, footnote number, and chapter number – can all be used in the reference.
- Each reference and its components can have a specific character style or style override.
- Each reference part can be set to appear only in selected languages.
- Reference source can be chosen from style filtered lists and also from pre-made Source Marker. Source can be chosen from any open document (References can point across documents.)
- References can be hyperlinked for easy creation of electronic output.
- Easy customization of formats via dialog or XML.
- Relative page references, such as “previous” or “opposite page”, are supported and can be customized and localized.
- References – selected or all – can be converted to text .
- References within open documents are automatically updated.
- References can quote variables from the source text.
- FrameMaker cross-references are imported when used with DTP Tools MIF Filter import plug-in.
- Panel with references list, sources list and key features controls.
- Plug-in is fully scriptable in AppleScript, Java Script and VB Script
- Extensive InCopy workflow support.
- Convenient re-linking of external references.
- Formats can be loaded and saved using InDesign documents. Collaborate easily with the free Cross-References Reader plug-in, which enables InDesign users without Cross-References to open, print, export, and work in documents containing cross-references. Reader updates the references in real time and allows to convert them to text.
- Cross-References and the free Cross-References reader are available for InDesign and InCopy versions CS2–CS3. InDesign server version available upon request.
